

PRESIDENTS REPORT



Congratulations to all the Branch Awards Of Excellence nominees and winners and also to all to all of our Club Perpetual Award winners both Senior and Junior. These nominees and winners are all very well deserved and demonstrates the strength we have as a club across all the disciplines in Surf Lifesaving.

We thank Steve Lee who'll be stepping down as our DOL (Director of Lifesaving) at the end of the season and look forward to working with the person who'll take his place next season. We had another season of zero coastal drownings at patrolled beaches during the 22 – 23 season. This is a real credit to our volunteer members who patrol our beach every weekend and public holidays from September to April each year.

Paul Dowdell is also stepping down from his role of DOE (Director of Education). Paul has been pivotal to our club over the last few years and through his leadership the education team has grown exponentially to the point where we could be considered the leaders in the space of education across the Branch, helping other surf clubs delivering and assessing courses and also mentoring other clubs training officers.

Our competitive team across the club from Nippers to Masters continued to excel this competition season. The highlight for me was our Masters team, who at State finished 4th overall. This achievement is the best ever result for Shelly Beach, in a very competitive field of 129 clubs across NSW, the Masters also came 1st place in the Central Coast Branch. That result is the best ever at any level across the club, at a state level event. A truly inspirational moment.

Some of the team undertook the massive commitment to travel over to Perth to compete at the Australians and came away with more medals and personal bests.

The Nipper Program has been engaging and fun for all the children who either started or continued their journey through the ranks of lifesaving to become qualified lifesavers. Roughly 200 children spread across the 9 age groups were supported by Craig and his team who educated, trained and engaged those Nippers developing their water and sand skills. The JAC team attended every weekend to set up for Nippers regardless of weather conditions. Most importantly those Nippers have gained the confidence so that they can self-rescue and enjoy the beach safely.

The Finance and Sponsorship team have ensured we are in a good financial position going forward with strong sponsorship and fundraising contributions. We have received record levels of fundraising and records levels of sponsorship this last season, and we thank everyone involved in this great result.

We have re-signed with The Balcony Restaurant to another long-term partnership, and we have delivered a first by offering a member discount card for use at our bar, we are also offering to waive the coming season membership fee for those who have gained 100% of their rostered patrol hours, another first for the club. This is our way of acknowledging the ongoing commitment and tireless hours that our members give up every season.

Club Captain's Report

This season saw a return to normality after previous years being affected by Covid and the procedures surrounding it. This year saw us having to drop to nine patrols due to the impact of Covid on our patrolling numbers and lack of new families joining the club. This has significantly improved throughout the year with new members completing their Bronze Medallion and other associated awards. A lot of credit must go to our ever-flourishing competition element which, due to its ever-improving performance, is attracting members from other clubs to join our ranks. Hopefully it will encourage some of them to patrol for us also next year!

Encouragingly we have seen new IRB drivers trained this year, I urge these drivers to continue to hone their skills at carnivals and Nippers and repay the club, and its trainers, by assisting in these areas. We are finding the same long serving members still having to donate their time again and again due to the lack of support in these areas. It is at these times branch recognise you donating your time and gaining experience, supporting you in future course applications such as RWC.

This year our members again made Shelly Beach a safe place to swim for the sixty-seven thousand members of the public who visited our beach this year. We performed over fifty rescues, provided first aid to twenty-nine people, prevented over one thousand one hundred possible drownings and donated over seven thousand four hundred hours of our time.

This year is my final year as Director of Lifesaving, a role I have thoroughly enjoyed and privileged to have been voted, by who, to represent you in this role. It has been a testing role for me with my shift work, commute and having to deal with Covid but I look back at my time and am happy with some of the improvements made to the club such as the new patrol wagon, the new dual hull IRB trailer, improved radios and what will soon be finalised in the IRB room with the new workbench and overhead storage of the spare hull.

Many thanks to each and every member of our club who has donated their time and will continue to donate their time. I look forward to seeing you down the club for 'Friday sips.'

After the last 2 years of COVID restrictions and problematic weather to deal with, the Shelly Beach Education team got back to what they do best, delivering a wide range of courses right here at our own club.

This year our education team members have been involved in delivering First Aid, Advanced Resuscitation Techniques, Surf Rescue Certificates, Bronze Medallion, IRB Crew, Silver Medallion IRB Driver, and Silver Medallion Aquatic Rescue, and Gold Medallions at both club and branch levels. Across branch our team helped deliver over 130 awards to Central Coast Life Saving members.



Director of Surf Sports Annual Report

This seasons goal for the Shelly Beach Surf Sports team was to build on the success of past seasons. We attempted to this in a variety of ways from targeting quality carnivals, bolstering the coaching ranks and developing the skills of our members.

The 2022-23 season saw a return to the first full season in some time, with no COVID restrictions, weather conditions or natural disasters impacting on carnivals. The 2022-23 season has been the most successful in the club's history with the highest medal tallies achieved at the major carnivals.

These competitors trained for many hours and ticking over many kilometres in preparation for the ultimate endurance challenge in Surf Sports. Daniel Lockwood completed the individual long course, claiming Bronze in the 40-50years age division. Robbie Wait, Christian Wait and Jazmyn Fillingham all successfully completed the individual short course in their respective age divisions.



NSW Interbranch Championships

Shelly Beach Surf Club hosted the NSW Interbranch Championships this season. It was a great honour for the club to organise this carnival and allowed the best competitors in NSW to test their skills against the challenging conditions of Shelly Beach. This season Shelly had 5 competitors selected to represent Central Coast: Bryn Gaha (Captain), Jazzmyn Fillingham, Tahlia Goy (Jnr Captain), Charlie McGeever and Zach Adams. The team was also supported by other members in coaching and management roles: Keaton Watts and David Smith (coaches), Dan Kingsley and Michael Hyslop (team managers). Thank you to all the members that assisted in the organisation of the carnival. The NSW management were extremely impressed with the passion and drive that the Shelly Beach members displayed in hosting the Interbranch Championships.

Branch Championships

The Branch Championships was once again a highly successful weekend of competition with the club finishing 7th in the Nippers, 3rd in the Opens and 2nd in the Masters. The overall medal haul for Shelly Beach at the Branch totalled to an enormous tally of 53 gold, 55 silver and 51 bronze.

State Championships

The 2022-23 State Championships were hosted on the Sydney Northern Beaches, at Queenscliff, Manly and Freshwater Beaches. The club had placed an amazing 4th in the Masters, 10th in the Nippers and 22nd in the Opens. At these championships, Shelly Beach competitors won 9 Gold, 10 Silver and 10 Bronze.




